

## 'Definition'

Sustainability is a broad concept encompassing interlinking dimensions of environmental responsibility, economic health, social equity and cultural vitality. As sustainability is not constricted by the 'ability to sustain', it calls for institutions to focus on creating sustainable futures that incorporate innovation, restoration and rejuvenation.
